- 1. Applicants must be members of the church in the last three (3) consecutive years at the time of application. Students, who are not members, but have "grown up" in Zion Pilgrim Baptist Church within the last five (5) consecutive years," are also eligible to apply.
- 2. Applicants must submit all required documentation: application, typed essay, copy of high school transcript, college acceptance letter and copy of SAT or ACT score.
- 3. Applicants must be high school graduates in the current academic year.
- 4. Applicants must complete the <u>online application and upload</u> transcript, SAT or ACT score, essay, copy of college acceptance letter and senior picture. <u>To upload attachments, first, scan them into a single file. Make sure they are legible. Then upload the file to: erinstewartscholarship@zionpilgrimbaptistchurch.org</u>
- 5. The Scholarship has 3 Tiers. Tier 1- \$1000 Tier 2- \$500 and Tier 3- \$250

Criteria for selection include:

1. **Scholastic ability:** Submit copies of SAT or ACT scores (if available), high school transcripts and college acceptance letter with your application.

Typed essay: Theme: "How the Church Worship Experience and Support Ministries Have Impacted My Life"

The essay must be double spaced on a single (1) sheet of paper and it should incorporate the roles of education and church in your life. The essay must demonstrate clarity, coherence, proper grammar usage, mechanics, adherence to the theme, and enough details to develop the concept.
